AN ACT in relation to extending the deadline by which an eligible municipality may exercise the provisions of the Superstorm Sandy assessment relief act

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter or any other law to the contrary, the town of Smithtown may exercise the provisions of the superstorm sandy assessment relief act if its town board shall, by the three hundred sixty-fifth day following October twenty-second, two thousand thirteen, pass a local law adopting the provisions of this act. The town of Smithtown may provide assessment relief for real property impacted by Superstorm Sandy located within the town of Smithtown as provided in paragraphs (i), (ii), (iii) and/or (iv) of subdivision (a) of section four of the superstorm sandy assessment relief act only if its town board specifically elects to do so as part of such local law or resolution.

12 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
