AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to restricting access to dextromethorphan, commonly known as "dxm"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 391-s to read as follows:
- S 391-S. RESTRICTED ACCESS TO RETAIL SALE OF DEXTROMETHORPHAN, COMMONLY KNOWN AS "DXM". 1. NO RETAIL ESTABLISHMENT OFFERING FOR SALE ANY PRODUCT OR PRODUCTS CONTAINING AS AN ACTIVE INGREDIENT DEXTROMETHOR-PHAN, SHALL PERMIT THE SALE OF SUCH PRODUCTS TO PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN. RETAIL ESTABLISHMENTS SHALL REQUIRE PROOF OF AGE FOR LEGAL PURCHASE OF SUCH PRODUCTS. ANY RETAIL ESTABLISHMENT WHICH VIOLATES THE 9 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF TWO 10 FIFTY DOLLARS FOR EACH SUCH VIOLATION.
