AN ACT in relation to allowing Karen McClure to file a request for Tier II status in the New York state and local employees' retirement system

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, Karen McClure, who is a member of the New York state and local employees' system, and who was employed as a city auditor in the city of Olean and in the county of Cattaraugus for the period beginning July 1973 5 ending September 1973, and who was employed as a treasurer for the coun-6 of Cattaraugus for the period beginning July 1974 and ending September 1976, and who for reasons not ascribable to her own negligence did 7 8 not become a member of the New York state and local employees' retirement system at the time of her hiring and who is currently a 9 member of the New York state and local employees' retirement system 10 shall be deemed to have become a member of such system as of 11 July 1, 1973 entitling her to Tier II status with every right, benefit and priv-12 13 ilege which would have been available to her on such date if, within one year of the effective date of this act, she shall file a written request 14 15 that effect with the state comptroller. Upon the granting of such retroactive membership, Karen McClure shall be granted a refund of 16 employee contributions made by her to the New York state and local 17 18 retirement system.

- 19 S 2. All past service costs associated with the implementation of this 20 act shall be borne by the state of New York.
- 21 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

FISCAL NOTE. -- Pursuant to Legislative Law, Section 50:

EXPLANATION--Matter in ITALICS (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [] is old law to be omitted.

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This bill will deem Karen McClure to have become a member of the New York State and Local Employees' Retirement System on July 1, 1973, her first date of employment with the city of Olean, thereby granting her Tier 2 status. All member contributions will be refunded.

If this bill is enacted, we anticipate that there will be an increase of approximately \$2,790 in the annual contributions of Erie County for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2015.

In addition to the annual contributions discussed above, there will be an immediate past service cost of approximately \$58,700 which will be borne by the State of New York as a one-time payment. This estimate is based on the assumption that payment will be made on March 1, 2015.

Summary of relevant resources:

The membership data used in measuring the impact of the proposed change was the same as that used in the March 31, 2013 actuarial valuation. Distributions and other statistics can be found in the 2013 Report of the Actuary and the 2013 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report.

The actuarial assumptions and methods used are described in the 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013 Annual Report to the Comptroller on Actuarial Assumptions, and the Codes Rules and Regulations of the State of New York: Audit and Control.

The Market Assets and GASB Disclosures are found in the March 31, 2013 New York State and Local Retirement System Financial Statements and Supplementary Information.
