AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to the restoration of a driver's license in certain cases

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 510 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 7-a to read as follows:

3 LICENSE RESTORATION. (A) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY INCONSISTENT WHEN A PERSON HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF A PROVISION OF THIS CHAPTER, VIOLATION OF ANY SUBDIVISION OF SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-TWO OF 6 CHAPTER OR HAS BEEN ADJUDICATED A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER PURSUANT TO A 7 VIOLATION OF ANY SUBDIVISION OF SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-TWO OF CHAPTER, OR HAS BEEN FOUND TO HAVE OPERATED A MOTOR VEHICLE AFTER 9 HAVING CONSUMED ALCOHOL IN VIOLATION OF SECTION ELEVEN NINETY-TWO-A OF THIS CHAPTER, AND AS A RESULT IS SUBJECT TO A REVOCATION 10 11 SUSPENSION OF A LICENSE OR PRIVILEGE TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE IN THIS STATE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION OR SECTION 12 ELEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-THREE OF THIS CHAPTER, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL NOT RESTORE SUCH 13 14 LICENSE OR PRIVILEGE UNLESS SUCH PERSON HAS DEMONSTRATED, ON FORMS 15 BY THE COMMISSIONER, THAT HE OR SHE HAS COMPLETELY SATISFIED PRESCRIBED 16 ALL OF THE APPLICABLE REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE THIS CHAPTER AND ANY OTHER APPLICABLE PROVISION OF THIS 17 THIRTY-ONE OF CHAPTER, AND HAS COMPLIED IN FULL WITH ANY OTHER CONDITIONS OF 18 19 IMPOSED BY THE COURT, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE PAYMENT IN 20 FULL OF ALL FINES AND MANDATORY SURCHARGES.

(B) THE COMMISSIONER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE OFFICE OF COURT ADMINISTRATION, SHALL PROMULGATE REGULATIONS TO EFFECTUATE THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBDIVISION AND PARAGRAPH (G) OF SUBDIVISION TWO OF SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-THREE OF THIS CHAPTER.

VIOLATION OF ANY SUBDIVISION OF SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-TWO OF THIS CHAPTER OR HAS BEEN ADJUDICATED A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER PURSUANT TO A 3 VIOLATION OF ANY SUBDIVISION OF SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-TWO-A OF THIS CHAPTER, OR HAS BEEN FOUND TO HAVE OPERATED A MOTOR VEHICLE AFTER 5 HAVING CONSUMED ALCOHOL IN VIOLATION OF SECTION ELEVEN NINETY-TWO-A OF THIS CHAPTER, AND AS A RESULT IS SUBJECT TO A REVOCATION 7 SUSPENSION OF A LICENSE OR PRIVILEGE TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE IN THIS STATE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION OR SECTION FIVE HUNDRED TEN OF THIS 8 CHAPTER, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL NOT RESTORE SUCH LICENSE OR PRIVILEGE 9 10 UNLESS SUCH PERSON HAS DEMONSTRATED, ON FORMS PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMIS-THAT HE OR SHE HAS COMPLETELY SATISFIED ALL OF THE APPLICABLE 11 REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE THIRTY-ONE OF THIS CHAPTER AND 12 ANY OTHER APPLICABLE PROVISION OF THIS CHAPTER, AND HAS COMPLIED IN FULL 13 14 WITH ANY OTHER CONDITIONS OF SENTENCING IMPOSED BY THE COURT, INCLUDING, 15 BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE PAYMENT IN FULL OF ALL FINES AND MANDATORY 16 SURCHARGES.

- 17 (2) THE COMMISSIONER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE OFFICE OF COURT ADMIN-18 ISTRATION, SHALL PROMULGATE REGULATIONS TO EFFECTUATE THE PROVISIONS OF 19 THIS SUBDIVISION AND SUBDIVISION SEVEN-A OF SECTION FIVE HUNDRED TEN OF 20 THIS CHAPTER.
- 21 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
