AN ACT Authorizing the town of Brookhaven to re-convey to Rock Solid Corporation parcels of land not needed for open space purposes

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the town of Brookhaven, county of Suffolk, acting by and through its town board, is hereby authorized to re-convey to Rock Solid Corporation upon such terms it deems reasonable, but without monetary consideration, those parcels of land described in section two of this act, which are no longer needed for open space purposes.

S 2. The parcels of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, erected situate, lying and being in the town of Brookhaven, county of Suffolk, state of New York, known and designated as Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 8 on a certain map entitled "Map of Village Woods Situate Bellport". Said map was filed in the office of the clerk for the county of Suffolk on the twenty-first day of January, two thousand nine, as map number 11675.
