- AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to alcohol, tobacco and drug abuse education

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph a of subdivision 4 of section 804 of the educa-2 tion law, as amended by chapter 181 of the laws of 2000, is amended to 3 read as follows:

4 a. The commissioner may prescribe in regulations such health education 5 courses which include instruction regarding alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs as the commissioner may deem necessary and desirable for the б 7 welfare of pupils and the community. The contents may be varied to meet the needs of particular school districts, or portions thereof, and need 8 9 not be uniform throughout the state, provided, however, that school districts shall utilize either the curriculum for health education 10 11 instruction regarding alcohol, tobacco and other drugs prescribed by the commissioner or a course approved by the commissioner in accordance with 12 criteria established by the commissioner. THE COMMISSIONER IS AUTHORIZED 13 TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE BOARD OF REGENTS 14 BEGINNING DECEMBER 15 FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FOURTEEN AND EVERY THREE YEARS THEREAFTER RELATING 16 TO THE MODERNIZATION OF SUCH INSTRUCTION REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SUBDIVI-SION ONE OF THIS SECTION, TO INCLUDE THE MOST UP TO DATE AGE APPROPRIATE 17 INFORMATION AVAILABLE REGARDING THE MISUSE AND ABUSE OF ALCOHOL, TOBACCO 18 AND OTHER DRUGS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO HEROIN AND OPIOIDS. 19 SUCH 20 INSTRUCTION SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, INFORMATION REGARDING 21 DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES THAT ARE MORE PREVALENT AMONG SCHOOL AGED YOUTH. SUCH RECOMMENDATIONS SHALL BE THE RESULT OF 22 A COLLABORATION THE DEPARTMENT, THE OFFICE OF ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE 23 BETWEEN
