- AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to establishing a task force to study how to improve investigations of animal abuse and enforcement of anti-animal abuse laws; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The agriculture and markets law is amended by adding a new 2 section 380 to read as follows:

3 TASK FORCE ON HOW TO IMPROVE INVESTIGATIONS OF ANIMAL ABUSE S 380. AND ENFORCEMENT OF ANTI-ANIMAL ABUSE LAWS. 1. THE TASK FORCE ON 4 HOM TO 5 IMPROVE INVESTIGATIONS OF ANIMAL ABUSE AND ENFORCEMENT OF ANTI-ANIMAL 6 ABUSE LAWS IS HEREBY CREATED TO EXAMINE, EVALUATE AND DETERMINE HOW TO 7 IMPROVE INVESTIGATIONS OF ANIMAL ABUSE AND THE ENFORCEMENT OF ANTI-ANI-8 MAL ABUSE LAWS.

9 2.(A) SUCH TASK FORCE SHALL CONSIST OF NINE MEMBERS, EACH TO SERVE FOR 10 A TERM OF ONE CALENDAR YEAR. SUCH MEMBERS SHALL BE APPOINTED AS ONE SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR; ONE SHALL BE APPOINTED 11 FOLLOWS: 12 BY THE TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE; ONE SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE LEADER OF THE SENATE; ONE SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF 13 MINORITY 14 THE ASSEMBLY; ONE SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE ONE SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT 15 ASSEMBLY; 16 OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION; ONE SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE COMMISSION-17 ER OF HEALTH AND THE REMAINING TWO MEMBERS SHALL BE APPOINTED ΒY THE 18 COMMISSIONER. APPOINTMENTS SHALL BE MADE WITHIN SIXTY DAYS OF THE EFFEC-

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TIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION. VACANCIES IN THE TASK FORCE SHALL BE FILLED 1 2 IN THE MANNER PROVIDED FOR ORIGINAL APPOINTMENTS. 3 (B) ALL APPOINTEES SHALL HAVE EXPERTISE IN FIELDS OR DISCIPLINES 4 RELATED TO ANIMALS, ANIMAL ABUSE AND/OR INVESTIGATIONS. ALL APPOINTMENTS 5 SHALL BE COORDINATED TO ENSURE GEOGRAPHIC REPRESENTATION FROM THE 6 ENTIRE STATE. 7 TASK FORCE SHALL BE CHAIRED BY ONE OF THE COMMISSIONER'S (C) THE 8 APPOINTEES. THE TASK FORCE SHALL ELECT A VICE-CHAIR AND OTHER NECESSARY 9 OFFICERS FROM AMONG ALL APPOINTED MEMBERS. 10 A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE TASK FORCE THEN IN OFFICE SHALL (D) CONSTITUTE A QUORUM FOR THE TRANSACTION OF BUSINESS OR THE EXERCISE OF 11 12 ANY POWER OR FUNCTION OF THE TASK FORCE. AN ACT, DETERMINATION OR DECI-SION OF THE MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS PRESENT DURING THE PRESENCE OF A 13 14 QUORUM SHALL BE HELD TO BE THE ACT, DETERMINATION, OR DECISION OF THE 15 TASK FORCE. (E) THE TASK FORCE SHALL MEET AT LEAST QUARTERLY AT THE CALL OF 16 THE 17 MEETINGS MAY BE HELD VIA TELECONFERENCE. SPECIAL MEETINGS MAY BE CHAIR. CALLED BY THE CHAIR AT THE REQUEST OF A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF 18 THE 19 TASK FORCE. 20 (F) MEMBERS OF THE TASK FORCE SHALL RECEIVE NO COMPENSATION FOR THEIR 21 SERVICES BUT SHALL BE REIMBURSED FOR THEIR ACTUAL EXPENSES INCURRED IN 22 THE PERFORMANCE OF THEIR DUTIES IN THE WORK OF THE TASK FORCE. 23 3. THE TASK FORCE ESTABLISHED SHALL: (A) STUDY CURRENT ANIMAL ABUSE INVESTIGATION AND ANTI-ANIMAL ABUSE LAW 24 25 ENFORCEMENT PRACTICES; AND RECOMMEND ANIMAL ABUSE 26 (B) INVESTIGATION AND ANTI-ANIMAL ABUSE LAW 27 ENFORCEMENT PRACTICES TO INCREASE EFFECTIVENESS ACROSS THE STATE. 28 4. THE TASK FORCE MAY ESTABLISH SUCH ADVISORY COMMITTEES AS IT DEEMS 29 APPROPRIATE ON MATTERS RELATING TO THE TASK FORCE'S FUNCTIONS, POWERS AND DUTIES. SUCH COMMITTEES SHALL BE CHAIRED BY A TASK FORCE MEMBER, BUT 30 MAY BE COMPOSED OF TASK FORCE MEMBERS AS WELL AS OTHER INDIVIDUALS 31 32 SELECTED BY THE TASK FORCE TO PROVIDE EXPERTISE OF INTEREST SPECIFIC TO 33 THE CHARGE OF SUCH COMMITTEE. 5. THE TASK FORCE MAY, AS IT DEEMS APPROPRIATE, REQUEST THAT 34 STUDIES, 35 SURVEYS, OR ANALYSES RELATING TO THE TASK FORCE'S POWERS AND DUTIES BE PERFORMED BY ANY STATE DEPARTMENT, COMMISSION, AGENCY OR PUBLIC AUTHORI-36 37 TY. ALL STATE DEPARTMENTS, COMMISSIONS, AGENCIES OR PUBLIC AUTHORITIES 38 SHALL PROVIDE INFORMATION AND ADVICE IN A TIMELY MANNER AND OTHERWISE 39 ASSIST THE TASK FORCE WITH ITS WORK. 40 6. THE TASK FORCE SHALL SUBMIT A REOUEST FOR ANY APPROPRIATION AS SHALL BE NECESSARY TO ENABLE THE TASK FORCE TO PERFORM ITS FUNCTIONS AND 41 DUTIES TO THE GOVERNOR, DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF THE BUDGET, AND 42 43 CHAIRPERSONS OF THE SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE AND THE ASSEMBLY WAYS AND 44 MEANS COMMITTEE. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE STAFF SERVICES TO THE TASK 45 FORCE AND SUCH OTHER ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANCE AS MAY BE NECESSARY FOR THE TASK FORCE TO CARRY OUT ITS DUTIES, FUNCTIONS AND POWERS. 46 47 7. THE TASK FORCE MAY HOLD PUBLIC HEARINGS, TAKE TESTIMONY AND MAKE 48 INVESTIGATIONS AT SUCH PLACES AS IT DEEMS NECESSARY. 49 THE TASK FORCE SHALL MAKE A PRELIMINARY REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND 8. 50 THE LEGISLATURE OF ITS FINDINGS, CONCLUSIONS, RECOMMENDATIONS AND ACTIV-51 ITIES ALREADY UNDERTAKEN BY THE TASK FORCE, NOT LATER THAN ONE YEAR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION, AND A FINAL REPORT OF ITS 52 FINDINGS, CONCLUSIONS, RECOMMENDATIONS AND ACTIVITIES ALREADY UNDERTAKEN

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1 S 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 2 have become a law and shall expire twenty-four months after it shall 3 have become a law when upon such date the provisions of this act shall 4 be deemed repealed.
