AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to who may request studies and analyses of the administration or operation of a criminal justice agency

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 5 of section 837 of the executive law, as added by chapter 399 of the laws of 1972 and as renumbered by chapter 603 of the laws of 1973, is amended to read as follows:
- 5. Conduct studies and analyses of the administration or operations of any criminal justice agency when requested by the head of such agency OR THE MUNICIPALITY, COUNTY EXECUTIVE OR LEGISLATIVE BODY OF WHICH THE AGENCY IS LOCATED, and make the results thereof available for the bene-8 fit of such agency;
- 9 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
