AN ACT to amend the public housing law, in relation to the performance of a study regarding homeless persons who are veterans in the state of New York

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 14 of the public housing law is amended by adding a new paragraph (q) to read as follows:

TO CONDUCT A STUDY, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE OFFICE OF TEMPORARY 3 AND DISABILITY ASSISTANCE, DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, AND OFFICE OF 5 FAMILY SERVICES TO DETERMINE THE NUMBER OF HOMELESS PERSONS IN NEW 6 YORK STATE THAT ARE VETERANS. SUCH STUDY SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT 7 IN NEW YORK STATE WHO ARE LIMITED TO: (I) AN ANALYSIS OF VETERANS 8 CURRENTLY HOMELESS, OR HAVE BEEN HOMELESS WITHIN FIVE YEARS OF BEING 9 FROM ACTIVE DUTY INCLUDING AN ANALYSIS OF GENDER AS IT RELATES 10 TO HOMELESSNESS OF VETERANS; (II) DATA ON THE NUMBER OF CHILDREN THE CURRENT PLACEMENT OF SUCH CHILDREN; HOMELESS VETERANS, INCLUDING (III) CASES OF MILITARY SEXUAL TRAUMA EXPERIENCED BY HOMELESS 12 WHILE ON ACTIVE DUTY OR DURING MILITARY TRAINING, INCLUDING A BREAKDOWN 13

OF THE COLLECTED DATA BASED UPON THE GENDER OF THE VICTIM; AND (IV) THE UNEMPLOYMENT RATE FOR NEW YORK STATE VETERANS. THE TERM "CHILDREN OF HOMELESS VETERANS" SHALL MEAN A PERSON WHO IS UNMARRIED AND WHO IS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN YEARS, AND IS THE BIOLOGICAL OR LEGALLY ADOPTED CHILD OF A VETERAN. A WRITTEN REPORT OF SUCH STUDY SHALL BE DELIVERED TO THE GOVERNOR, THE SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY AND THE TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE BY JUNE THIRTIETH, TWO THOUSAND SEVENTEEN AND SUCH INFORMATION REQUIRED PURSUANT TO THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE UPDATED EVERY TWO YEARS.
