AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to suspension of a person's privilege to operate a pleasure vessel and suspension of a person's vessel registration

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1193 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 3 to read as follows:
 - 3. SUSPENSION OF THE PRIVILEGE TO OPERATE A PLEASURE VESSEL. A COURT SHALL, UPON REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF A PERSON'S MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE AS A RESULT OF A VIOLATION OF THIS ARTICLE, SUSPEND A PERSON'S PRIVILEGE TO OPERATE A PLEASURE VESSEL AND MAY SUSPEND SUCH PERSON'S VESSEL REGISTRATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION FORTY-NINE-A OF THE NAVIGATION LAW. FOLLOWING THE PERIOD OF REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION IMPOSED BY THE COURT, A PERSON'S PRIVILEGE TO OPERATE A PLEASURE VESSEL AND VESSEL REGISTRATION
