AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to licensee liability for nuclear electric generating and decommissioning facilities

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 29-c of the executive law, as added by chapter 708 of the laws of 1981, is amended to read as follows:

- (a) Any licensee of the United States nuclear regulatory commission for a nuclear electric generating facility OR DECOMMISSIONING FACILITY, WITH AN ACTIVE LICENSE, shall be liable for an annual fee to support state and local governmental responsibilities under accepted radiological emergency preparedness plans related to the facility operated by such licensee. A LICENSEE SHALL NO LONGER BE LIABLE FOR FEES PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION, UPON TERMINATION OF THEIR LICENSE WITH SUCH COMMISSION.
