WHEREAS, This esteemed young woman has made four straight trips to the New York State Championships and was a member of the 2013-2014 USA Swimming Scholastic All-America Team; and

WHEREAS, During the 2014-2015 season, Andrea Ernst won her second consecutive New York State Championship in the 100-yard freestyle; her winning time at the state meet was 50.88, the very same time she won in the previous year; and

WHEREAS, In addition, Andrea Ernst took second place at the state meet in the 50 yard freestyle, and set an Orchard Park record in an All-American time of 23.40 in the preliminaries; she also anchored second-place finishes for the Quakers in the 200 and 400 free relays and helped lead her team to a third place finish with 172 points; and

WHEREAS, Andrea Ernst will look to earn a third consecutive state title in her senior year, and has already attracted attention from numerous major Division I swim programs; and

WHEREAS, Sports competition instills the values of teamwork, pride and accomplishment, and Andrea Ernst has clearly made a contribution to the spirit of excellence which is a tradition of her school; now, therefore, be it
