WHEREAS, The Oneonta Lions Club participates in the Lions Recycle for Sight, a used eyeglasses recycling program; throughout the years, this vital organization has collected thousands of eyeglasses for distribution to people in need in developing nations; and

WHEREAS, In addition, the Oneonta Lions Club has assisted hundreds of area residents to obtain necessary eye care; and

WHEREAS, Today, under the luminous leadership of President Joe Camarata, the Oneonta Lions Club supports numerous local projects including Camp Badger, K-9 Freedom Guide Dog Training Program, Family Service's Association's Helping Hand Program, Family Services Emergency Fund, Family Services Adopt-a-Family at Christmas, Adopt-A-Mile Highway Cleanup, Pit Run Mile Marker, Huntington Library, and Lions SEE early vision screening, as well as an Annual Halloween Parade; and
