- AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to state appropriations to the state university of New York and the city university of New York

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Clause (iv) of subparagraph 4 of paragraph h of subdivision 2 2 of section 355 of the education law, as amended by chapter 260 of the 3 laws of 2011, is renumbered clause (v) and a new clause (iv) is added to 4 read as follows:

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1 DECLARES A FISCAL EMERGENCY, AND COMMUNICATES SUCH EMERGENCY TO THE 2 TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY, STATE 3 SUPPORT FOR OPERATING EXPENSES AT THE STATE UNIVERSITY AND CITY UNIVER-4 SITY MAY BE REDUCED IN A MANNER PROPORTIONATE TO ONE ANOTHER, AND THE 5 AFOREMENTIONED PROVISIONS SHALL NOT APPLY.

6 S 2. Clause (iv) of subparagraph 4 of paragraph h of subdivision 2 of 7 section 355 of the education law, as amended by chapter 309 of the laws 8 of 1996, is renumbered clause (v) and a new clause (iv) is added to read 9 as follows:

10 (IV) THE STATE SHALL APPROPRIATE ANNUALLY AND MAKE AVAILABLE GENERAL FUND OPERATING SUPPORT INCLUDING FRINGE BENEFITS, FOR THE STATE UNIVER-11 SITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT LESS THAN THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED AND MADE 12 AVAIL-13 STATE UNIVERSITY IN STATE FISCAL YEAR TWO THOUSAND ABLE TO THE 14 ELEVEN--TWO THOUSAND TWELVE. BEGINNING IN STATE FISCAL YEAR TWO THOUSAND SIXTEEN--TWO THOUSAND SEVENTEEN AND THEREAFTER, THE STATE SHALL 15 APPRO-PRIATE AND MAKE AVAILABLE GENERAL FUND OPERATING SUPPORT FOR THE STATE 16 UNIVERSITY AND THE STATE UNIVERSITY HEALTH SCIENCE CENTERS IN AN 17 AMOUNT LESS THAN THE AMOUNTS SEPARATELY APPROPRIATED AND MADE AVAILABLE IN 18 NOT 19 THE PRIOR STATE FISCAL YEAR; PROVIDED, FURTHER, THE STATE SHALL APPRO-20 AND MAKE AVAILABLE GENERAL FUND OPERATING SUPPORT TO COVER ALL PRIATE 21 MANDATORY COSTS OF THE STATE UNIVERSITY AND THE STATE UNIVERSITY HEALTH SCIENCE CENTERS, WHICH SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, COLLECTIVE 22 BARGAINING COSTS INCLUDING SALARY INCREMENTS, FRINGE BENEFITS, AND OTHER 23 NON-PERSONAL SERVICE COSTS SUCH AS UTILITY COSTS, BUILDING RENTALS AND 24 25 OTHER INFLATIONARY EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE STATE UNIVERSITY AND THE 26 STATE UNIVERSITY HEALTH SCIENCE CENTERS. IF THE GOVERNOR, HOWEVER, DECLARES A FISCAL EMERGENCY, AND COMMUNICATES SUCH EMERGENCY TO THE 27 TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY, THE STATE 28 SUPPORT FOR OPERATING EXPENSES AT THE STATE UNIVERSITY AND CITY UNIVER-29 30 SITY MAY BE REDUCED IN A MANNER PROPORTIONATE TO ONE ANOTHER, AND THE AFOREMENTIONED PROVISIONS SHALL NOT APPLY. 31

S 3. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 7 of section 6206 of the education law, as amended by chapter 260 of the laws of 2011, is amended by adding a new subparagraph (iv) to read as follows:

35 STATE SHALL APPROPRIATE ANNUALLY AND MAKE AVAILABLE STATE (IV) THE 36 SUPPORT FOR OPERATING EXPENSES, INCLUDING FRINGE BENEFITS, FOR THE CITY 37 UNIVERSITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT LESS THAT THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED AND MADE 38 AVAILABLE TO THE CITY UNIVERSITY IN STATE FISCAL YEAR TWO THOUSAND 39 ELEVEN--TWO THOUSAND TWELVE. 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1 S 4. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 7 of section 6206 of the education 2 law, as amended by chapter 327 of the laws of 2002, is amended by adding 3 a new subparagraph (iv) to read as follows:

4 (IV) THE STATE SHALL APPROPRIATE ANNUALLY AND MAKE AVAILABLE STATE 5 SUPPORT FOR OPERATING EXPENSES, INCLUDING FRINGE BENEFITS, FOR THE CITY 6 UNIVERSITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT LESS THAN THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED AND MADE 7 AVAILABLE TO THE CITY UNIVERSITY IN STATE FISCAL YEAR TWO THOUSAND 8 ELEVEN--TWO THOUSAND TWELVE. BEGINNING IN STATE FISCAL YEAR TWO THOUSAND SIXTEEN--TWO THOUSAND SEVENTEEN AND THEREAFTER, THE STATE SHALL APPRO-9 10 PRIATE AND MAKE AVAILABLE STATE SUPPORT FOR OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE CITY UNIVERSITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT LESS THAN THE AMOUNTS SEPARATELY APPRO-11 AVAILABLE IN THE PRIOR STATE FISCAL YEAR; PROVIDED, 12 PRIATED AND MADE FURTHER, THE STATE SHALL APPROPRIATE AND MAKE AVAILABLE GENERAL 13 FUND 14 OPERATING SUPPORT TO COVER ALL MANDATORY COSTS OF THE CITY UNIVERSITY, WHICH SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COSTS, 15 INCLUDING SALARY INCREMENTS, FRINGE BENEFITS, AND OTHER NON-PERSONAL 16 SERVICE COSTS SUCH AS UTILITY COSTS, BUILDING RENTALS AND OTHER INFLA-17 TIONARY EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE CITY UNIVERSITY. 18 ΙF THEGOVERNOR, 19 HOWEVER, DECLARES A FISCAL EMERGENCY, AND COMMUNICATES SUCH EMERGENCY TO 20 THE TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY, STATE 21 SUPPORT FOR OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE STATE UNIVERSITY AND CITY UNIVER-22 SITY MAY BE REDUCED IN A MANNER PROPORTIONATE TO ONE ANOTHER, AND THE 23 AFOREMENTIONED PROVISIONS SHALL NOT APPLY.

S 5. This act shall take effect immediately provided that:

(a) the amendments to subparagraph 4 of paragraph h of subdivision 2 of section 355 of the education law made by section one of this act shall be subject to the expiration and reversion of such subparagraph pursuant to chapter 260 of the laws of 2011, as amended, when upon such date section two of this act shall take effect; and

30 (b) the amendments to paragraph (a) of subdivision 7 of section 6206 31 of the education law made by section three of this act shall be subject 32 to the expiration and reversion of such paragraph pursuant to chapter 33 260 of the laws of 2011, as amended when upon such date section four of 34 this act shall take effect.
