AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to providing for identification cards for individuals with autism spectrum disorder

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new article 17-D to read as follows:

AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER CARD. UPON THE REQUEST OF A PERSON WITH AN AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER, OR THE GUARDIAN OR CAREGIVER OF SUCH THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ELIGIBILITY AND DOCUMENTATION CRITERIA ESTABLISHED FOR SUCH PURPOSE AND FOR A FEE NOT TO EXCEED FIVE DOLLARS, AN IDENTIFICATION CARD DENOTING THAT SUCH HAS BEEN MEDICALLY DIAGNOSED WITH AN AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER. SUCH CARD INDICATE THENAME, ADDRESS AND DATE OF BIRTH OF THE CARD BEARER SHALL AND, AT THE CARD BEARER'S DISCRETION, THE NAME AND PHONE INDIVIDUAL DESIGNATED BY THE CARD BEARER TO BE CONTACTED IN CASE OF EMERGENCY. THE CARD SHALL CONTAIN A STATEMENT EXPLAINING AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDERS, AND HOW THEY MAY GIVE RISE TO PHYSICAL AGITATION AND INDIVIDUAL'S ABILITY TO COMMUNICATE OR RESPOND TO DIRECTIONS. CARD SHALL FURTHER INDICATE THAT IT HAS BEEN ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE. THE IDENTIFICATION CARD MAY BE PRESENTED TO LAW ENFORCEMENT AS NECESSARY.
