AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to granting SUNY community college campus peace officers access to criminal history record information pursuant to 9 NYCRR 6051.1

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 6434 of the education law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 1-a to read as follows:
 - 1-A. FOR THE PURPOSE OF FACILITATING INVESTIGATIONS SUNY COMMUNITY COLLEGE CAMPUS PEACE OFFICERS SHALL BE DEEMED AUTHORIZED USERS, ABLE TO ACCESS CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION, PURSUANT TO 9 NYCRR 6051.1 SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING DUTIES:
- A. EACH COMMUNITY COLLEGE SHALL BE REQUIRED TO DOCUMENT EACH OFFICER'S ACTIVITY WITH REGARD TO ACCESSING SUCH INFORMATION AND THE OFFICER'S REASONABLE CAUSE FOR NEEDING SUCH ACCESS.
- 10 B. THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE SHALL ESTABLISH AN INTERNAL REVIEW PROCESS TO 11 ENSURE EVERY INQUIRY IS JUSTIFIED AND IS SUPPORTED BY SUFFICIENT REASON-12 ABLE CAUSE.
- 13 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
