AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to licenses to sell at retail for consumption on the premises

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 106 of the alcoholic beverage control law is
2 amended by adding a new subdivision 13-a to read as follows:
3 13-A. (A) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISION THIRTEEN OF
4 THIS SECTION THE STATE LIQUOR AUTHORITY MAY ISSUE A LICENSE UNDER
5 SECTION EIGHTY-ONE-A OF THIS CHAPTER TO THE OWNER, LESSOR AND/OR OPERA-
6 TOR OF PARCEL OR PARCELS DESCRIBED IN THIS PARAGRAPH:
7 ALL THAT CERTAIN PLOT, PIECE OR PARCEL OF LAND, SITUATE, LYING AND
8 BEING IN THE BOROUGH OF MANHATTAN, CITY, COUNTY AND STATE OF NEW YORK,
9 BOUNDED AND DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:
10 BEGINNING AT THE CORNER FORMED BY THE INTERSECTION OF THE EASTERLY
11 SIDE OF 3RD AVENUE WITH THE SOUTHERLY SIDE OF EAST 87TH STREET;
12 RUNNING THENCE EASTERLY ALONG THE SOUTHERLY SIDE OF EAST 87TH STREET,
13 125 FEET;
14 THENCE SOUTHERLY AND PARALLEL WITH 3RD AVENUE, 100 FEET 8-1/2 INCHES
15 TO THE CENTER LINE OF THE BLOCK;
16 THENCE WESTERLY ALONG SAID CENTER LINE ON THE BLOCK, 25 FEET;
17 THENCE SOUTHERLY AND PARALLEL WITH 3RD AVENUE, 22 FEET 8-1/2 INCHES;
18 THENCE WESTERLY AND PARALLEL WITH EAST 87TH STREET, 100 FEET TO THE
19 EASTERLY SIDE OF 3RD AVENUE;
20 THENCE NORTHERLY ALONG THE SAID EASTERLY SIDE OF 3RD AVENUE, 123 FEET
21 5 INCHES TO THE POINT OR PLACE OF BEGINNING.
22 (B) PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT THE OWNER, LESSOR AND/OR OPERATOR OF A
23 LICENSED PREMISES DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (A) OF THIS SUBDIVISION IS
24 PROHIBITED FROM SELLING ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MANUFACTURED OR SOLD AT
25 WHOLESALE BY ANY BUSINESS THAT IT HAS ANY DIRECT OR INDIRECT INTEREST
26 IN.
27 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
