AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the use of school district funds to install and maintain wood pellet, wood chip or other biomass burning boiler systems

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 3611-a to read as follows:

3 S 3611-A. SCHOOL DISTRICT FUNDS; SPECIAL USES. A SCHOOL DISTRICT IS 4 AUTHORIZED TO USE ANY FUNDS OTHERWISE DEDICATED FOR RENOVATIONS OR 5 REPAIRS TO A BUILDING WITHIN THE DISTRICT TO PAY FOR THE INSTALLATION 6 AND MAINTENANCE OF A WOOD PELLET, WOOD CHIPS OR OTHER BIOMASS BURNING 7 BOILER SYSTEM.

8 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
