- AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Corporal Nicholas K. Uzenski Memorial Highway"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-e to 2 read as follows:

3 PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE 344-Е. S 4 "CORPORAL NICHOLAS K. UZENSKI MEMORIAL HIGHWAY". ALL THAT PORTION OF THE 5 STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM CONSTITUTING STATE ROUTE THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN IN THE COUNTY OF DELAWARE, BEGINNING AT THE NORTHERNMOST INTERSECTION OF 6 7 STATE ROUTE THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN AND STATE ROUTE TWENTY-EIGHT IN 8 THE TOWN OF FRANKLIN, CONTINUING IN A GENERALLY WESTERLY DIRECTION, AND THE FRANKLIN AND SIDNEY TOWN LINE, SHALL BE 9 TERMINATING AT DESIGNATED 10 AND KNOWN AS THE "CORPORAL NICHOLAS K. UZENSKI MEMORIAL HIGHWAY".

11 S 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal-12 lation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system 13 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid 14 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-15 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 16 ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be 17 changed as a result of this act.

18 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
