AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to removing {1231} loflupane from the designation as a controlled substance

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Paragraph 4 of subdivision (b) of schedule II of section  
2     3306 of the public health law, as added by chapter 664 of the laws of  
3     1985, is amended to read as follows:  
4     (4) Coca leaves and any salt, compound, derivative, or preparation of  
5     coca leaves, and any salt, compound, derivative, or preparation thereof  
6     which is chemically equivalent or identical with any of these substances  
7     including cocaine and ecgonine, their salts, isomers, and salts of isom-  
8     ers, except that the substances shall not include decocainized coca  
9     leaves or extraction of coca leaves, which extractions do not contain  
10    cocaine [or], ecgonine OR {123L} IOFLUPANE.  
11    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
