AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to requiring annual firearms and other weapons training for police officers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraphs (b) and (c) of subdivision 1 of section 209-q of the general municipal law are relettered paragraphs (c) and (d) and a new paragraph (b) is added to read as follows:

(B) NO EMPLOYER SHALL ALLOW ANY POLICE OFFICER IT EMPLOYS TO CARRY OR USE A WEAPON DURING ANY PHASE OF THE OFFICER'S OFFICIAL DUTIES, WHICH CONSTITUTES ON-DUTY EMPLOYMENT, UNLESS THE OFFICER HAS SATISFACTORILY COMPLETED A COURSE OF TRAINING APPROVED BY THE MUNICIPAL POLICE TRAINING COUNCIL IN THE USE OF DEADLY PHYSICAL FORCE AND FIREARMS AND OTHER WEAPONS, AND ANNUALLY RECEIVES INSTRUCTION IN THE USE OF DEADLY PHYSICAL FORCE AND FIREARMS AND OTHER WEAPONS AS APPROVED BY THE MUNICIPAL POLICE TRAINING COUNCIL.

12 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-13 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
