AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to access to the special supplemental nutrition program for women, infants and children

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- The public health law is amended by adding a new section 1 Section 1. 2507 to read as follows:
 - S 2507. SPECIAL SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION PROGRAM FOR WOMEN, INFANTS AND CHILDREN; SPECIALTY INFANT FORMULA.
 - 1. DEFINITIONS. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION:

- "WIC" 6 SHALL MEAN THE SPECIAL SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION PROGRAM FOR WOMEN, INFANTS AND CHILDREN; 7
 - (B) "WIC VENDOR" SHALL MEAN A VENDOR WHICH HAS A CONTRACT TO PRODUCTS COVERED BY WIC TO INDIVIDUALS UNDER THE WIC PROGRAM; AND
- (C) "SPECIALTY INFANT FORMULA" 10 SHALL MEAN INFANT FORMULA THAT IS PRESCRIBED FOR A SPECIFIC MEDICAL CONDITION, FOR WHICH MEDICAL DOCUMEN-11 TATION MAY BE REQUIRED, UNDER REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSIONER. 12
 - WIC VENDOR SHALL BE AUTHORIZED TO SELL ANY PRODUCT COVERED UNDER WIC, INCLUDING SPECIALTY INFANT FORMULA, UNLESS SPECIFICALLY BARRED BY THE COMMISSIONER APPLYING REGULATIONS UNDER THIS LIMITED OR SECTION OR APPLICABLE FEDERAL REGULATIONS. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL APPLY ARBITRARY CRITERIA, OR CRITERIA THAT CREATE UNREASONABLE BARRIERS FOR WIC PARTICIPANTS TO ACCESS SPECIALTY INFANT FORMULA, AND SHALL ONLY APPLY CRITERIA THAT ARE REASONABLY RELATED TO AND CONSISTENT WITH: (A) PROMOTING WIC BENEFICIARY ACCESS TO SPECIALTY INFANT FORMULA;
- 20 ADMINISTRATION OF WIC WITH INTEGRITY, EFFICIENCY AND SECURITY. 21
- S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 22 23 it shall have become a law; provided, however, that effective immediate-
- 24 ly, the commissioner of health shall make regulations and take other 25 actions necessary to implement the provisions of this act.
