AN ACT to amend the tax law and the state finance law, in relation to  
providing a tax check-off box on personal income tax return forms for  
gifts to the school-based health centers fund

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-  
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. The tax law is amended by adding a new section 630-d to  
2     read as follows:  
3     S 630-D. GIFT FOR SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS. EFFECTIVE FOR ANY TAX  
4     YEAR COMMENCING ON OR AFTER JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND SIXTEEN, AN  
5     INDIVIDUAL IN ANY TAXABLE YEAR MAY ELECT TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE  
6     SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS FUND. SUCH CONTRIBUTION SHALL BE IN ANY  
7     WHOLE DOLLAR AMOUNT AND SHALL NOT REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF STATE TAX OWED BY  
8     SUCH INDIVIDUAL. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL INCLUDE SPACE ON THE PERSONAL  
9     INCOME TAX RETURN TO ENABLE A TAXPAYER TO MAKE SUCH CONTRIBUTION. THE  
10    COMMISSIONER SHALL ALSO ENSURE THAT A DESCRIPTION OF A SCHOOL-BASED  
11    HEALTH CENTER IS INCLUDED WITHIN THE TAX FORM PREPARATION INSTRUCTION  
12    BOOKLET. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW ALL REVENUES  
13    COLLECTED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE SCHOOL-BASED  
14    HEALTH CENTERS FUND AND USED ONLY FOR THOSE PURPOSES ENUMERATED IN  
15    SECTION EIGHTY-ONE OF THE STATE FINANCE LAW.  
16    S 2. The state finance law is amended by adding a new section 81 to  
17    read as follows:  
18    S 81. SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS FUND. 1. THERE IS HEREBY ESTABLISHED  
19    IN THE JOINT CUSTODY OF THE COMPTROLLER AND THE COMMISSIONER OF HEALTH,  
20    A SPECIAL FUND TO BE KNOWN AS THE "SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS FUND".  
21    2. SUCH FUND SHALL CONSIST OF ALL REVENUES RECEIVED PURSUANT TO THE  
22    PROVISIONS OF SECTION SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-D OF THE TAX LAW, AND ALL OTHER  
23    MONEYS APPROPRIATED, CREDITED, OR TRANSFERRED THERETO FROM ANY OTHER

EXPLANATION--Matter in *ITALICS* (underscored) is new; matter in brackets  
[ ] is old law to be omitted.

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1 FUND OR SOURCE PURSUANT TO LAW. NOTHING CONTAINED HEREIN SHALL PREVENT  
2 THE STATE FROM RECEIVING GRANTS, GIFTS OR BEQUESTS FOR THE PURPOSES OF  
3 THE FUND AS DEFINED IN THIS SECTION AND DEPOSITING THEM INTO THE FUND  
4 ACCORDING TO LAW.

5 3. MONIES OF THE FUND SHALL BE EXPENDED TO FUND EXPANSION OF MEDICAL  
6 SERVICES AT EXISTING SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS OR TO ESTABLISH NEW  
7 SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS.

8 4. MONIES SHALL BE PAYABLE FROM THE FUND ON THE AUDIT AND WARRANT OF  
9 THE COMPTROLLER ON VOUCHERS APPROVED AND CERTIFIED BY THE COMMISSIONER  
10 OF HEALTH.

11 5. AMOUNTS EXPENDED FOR SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS PURSUANT TO THIS  
12 SECTION SHALL NOT AFFECT THE AMOUNT THAT WOULD OTHERWISE BE APPROPRIATED  
13 FOR SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS UNDER ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW.

14 6. SERVICES PERFORMED BY SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS AVAILABLE FOR  
15 MONEYS FROM THIS FUND SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO:

16 A. COMPREHENSIVE PHYSICAL HEALTH AND MENTAL HEALTH ASSESSMENTS;

17 B. DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT OF ACUTE ILLNESSES;

18 C. VISION, HEARING, DENTAL, NUTRITIONAL, AND TUBERCULOSIS SCREENINGS;

19 D. ROUTINE MANAGEMENT OF CHRONIC DISEASES;

20 E. HEALTH EDUCATION;

21 F. MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING AND REFERRALS;

22 G. IMMUNIZATIONS;

23 H. WORKING PAPERS AND SPORTS PHYSICALS; AND

24 I. POPULATION-BASED PRIMARY PREVENTION.

25 SERVICES SHALL BE PROVIDED ON-SITE BY A MULTI-DISCIPLINARY TEAM  
26 CONSISTING OF A MID-LEVEL PRACTITIONER, A MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELOR, AND A  
27 MEDICAL ASSISTANT IN CONSULTATION WITH A PHYSICIAN. THE CENTERS SHALL  
28 ALSO PROVIDE ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE TWENTY-FOUR HOURS PER DAY, SEVEN DAYS  
29 PER WEEK.

30 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
