AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to requiring certain persons providing substance abuse treatment on counseling to complete training in medication assisted treatment

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new section 2 19.31 to read as follows:
- 3 S 19.31 MEDICATION ASSISTED TREATMENT TRAINING REQUIREMENT.
- PERSON WHO IS A CREDENTIALED ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE EVERY 5 COUNSELOR PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION (D) OF SECTION 19.07 OF THIS 6 A QUALIFIED HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL WHO PROVIDES TREATMENT OR COUN-7 SELING SERVICES AT A SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER FACILITY, AT A SCHOOL 8 ТО THE DRUG ADDICTION TREATMENT ACT OF 2000, SHALL, WITHIN PURSUANT 9 EIGHTEEN MONTHS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION OR WITHIN ONE YEAR 10 OF COMMENCING THE PROVISION OF ANY SUCH TREATMENT OR COUNSELING, LATER, SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE A COURSE OF INSTRUCTION 11 SHALL BE RELATING TO MEDICATION ASSISTED TREATMENT APPROVED BY THE OFFICE. 12
- S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law. Provided, that effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date is authorized and directed to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
