AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to recordkeeping requirements for second-hand dealers, scrap processors and pawnbrokers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new article 2 5-B to read as follows:

ARTICLE 5-B

RECORDKEEPING REQUIREMENTS FOR SECOND-HAND DEALERS, SCRAP PROCESSORS AND PAWNBROKERS

SECTION 57. REPORTS TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

57-A. RECORD OF PURCHASES AND SALES.

57-B. ELECTRONIC REPORTING TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

57-C. PENALTIES.

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S 57. REPORTS TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE. EVERY DEALER IN SECOND-HAND WHO DEALS IN THE PURCHASE OR SALE OF ANY SECOND-HAND MANUFAC-TURED ARTICLE COMPRISED WHOLLY OR IN PART OF GOLD, SILVER, PLATINUM, OR OTHER PRECIOUS METALS, OR DEALS IN THE PURCHASE OR SALE OF ANY OLD GOLD, PLATINUM OR OTHER PRECIOUS METALS, OR DEALS IN THE PURCHASE OF ARTICLES OR THINGS COMPRISED OF GOLD, SILVER, PLATINUM OR OTHER PRECIOUS METALS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MELTING OR REFINING, OR DEALS IN THE SALE OF USED ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES EXCLUDING KITCHEN APPLIANCES, OR DEALS IN THE PURCHASE OR SALE OF ANY USED ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT, PARTS OF ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT OR COMPUTERS, OR IS A ERS OR COMPONENT SCRAP PROCESSOR AS DEFINED IN SECTION SIXTY-NINE-E OF THIS SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE THE RECORDS REQUIRED TO KEPT PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISIONS ONE, TWO AND THREE FIFTY-SEVEN-A OF THIS ARTICLE WITH RESPECT TO SUCH TRANSACTIONS IN A MANNER SPECIFIED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THENEW YORK

  - D. IDENTIFYING INFORMATION REGARDING THE PERSON WHO IS PRESENT TO PURCHASE PROPERTY SOLD BY THE DEALER, INCLUDING NAME, ADDRESS, PHONE NUMBER, AND PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION AS APPARENT, INCLUDING SEX, AGE, HEIGHT, WEIGHT, EYE COLOR, HAIR COLOR, RACE OR ETHNICITY, AND DISTINGUISHING MARKS;
- E. AN ACCURATE DESCRIPTION OF EACH ARTICLE PURCHASED OR SOLD, INCLUD-44 ING TYPE OF ARTICLE, QUANTITY OR WEIGHT OF ARTICLE IF CONSISTS OF SCRAP METAL, MANUFACTURER, MAKE, MODEL NUMBER, SERIAL NUMBER, INTERNATIONAL MOBILE EQUIPMENT IDENTIFIER, ELECTRONIC SERIAL NUMBER, MOBILE EQUIPMENT IDENTIFIER, INSCRIPTIONS OR DISTINGUISHING MARKS, AND ONE OR MORE DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHS REASONABLY CAPTURING THE LIKENESS OF THE ARTICLE; 49 AND
- F. IN THE CASE OF A SALE OR OTHER DISPOSAL OF A MOTOR VEHICLE, MOTORCYCLE OR MOTOR THEREOF, THE DEALER IN SECOND-HAND ARTICLES SHALL, IN
  ADDITION TO ANY OTHER ENTRY REQUIRED, ENTER IN A PERMANENT RECORD THE
  WHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER OF SAID MOTOR VEHICLE, MOTORCYCLE OR
  MOTOR, THE MANNER IN WHICH SAID MOTOR VEHICLE, MOTORCYCLE OR MOTOR WAS
  REMOVED FROM THE PREMISES, GIVING THE NAME, ADDRESS AND DATE OF BIRTH OF
  THE PERSON WHO REMOVES IT, THE DRIVER'S LICENSE NUMBER OF SUCH PERSON

AND STATE OF ISSUANCE IF SUCH PERSON POSSESSED A DRIVER'S LICENSE, THE MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION NUMBER OF ANY VEHICLE USED TO TOW, REMOVE OR TRANSPORT SUCH MOTOR VEHICLE, MOTORCYCLE OR MOTOR, AND THE DESTINATION TO WHICH THE MOTOR VEHICLE, MOTORCYCLE OR MOTOR IS BEING REMOVED.

SUCH ELECTRONIC RECORD MAY, IN 13 14 DISCRETION OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE AND IN FURTHERANCE OF THE PURPOSES OF THIS ARTICLE AND ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAW OR RULES REGULATING 16 ACTIVITIES OF DEALERS IN SECOND-HAND ARTICLES WHO ARE SUCH SCRAP PROCES-17 SORS, INCLUDE BUT SHALL NOT BE LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION, 18 PROVIDED IN A FORMAT OR IN ACCORDANCE WITH SPECIFICATIONS AS PROVIDED BY 19 RULE OR REGULATION OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THE NEW YORK STATE 20 DEPARTMENT OF STATE:
- A. EACH PURCHASE OF ANY PIG OR PIGS OF METAL, BRONZE OR BRASS CASTINGS OR PARTS THEREOF, SPRUES OR GATES OR PARTS THEREOF, UTILITY WIRE OR BRASS CAR JOURNALS, OR OF METAL BEER KEGS;
  - B. EACH PURCHASE OF IRON, STEEL AND/OR NON-FERROUS SCRAP FOR A PRICE OF FIFTY DOLLARS OR MORE;
  - C. AN ACCURATE DESCRIPTION OF EACH ARTICLE PURCHASED, PROCESSED OR SHIPPED, INCLUDING THE TYPE OF ARTICLE AND QUANTITY OF EACH TYPE OF ARTICLE AND THE VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE OR MOTOR VEHICLE PART, IF APPLICABLE;
    - D. THE DATE OF SUCH PURCHASE;
    - E. THE NAME OF THE SELLER;

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- 32 F. THE RESIDENCE OF THE SELLER BY STREET, NUMBER, CITY, VILLAGE OR 33 TOWN;
  - G. THE DRIVER'S LICENSE NUMBER OR INFORMATION FROM A GOVERNMENT ISSUED PHOTOGRAPHIC IDENTIFICATION CARD, IF ANY, OF SUCH PERSON, OR BY SUCH DESCRIPTION AS WILL REASONABLY LOCATE THE SELLER;
  - H. A COPY OF THE GOVERNMENT ISSUED PHOTOGRAPHIC IDENTIFICATION CARD USED TO VERIFY THE IDENTITY OF THE PERSON FROM WHOM THE SCRAP METAL WAS PURCHASED, WHICH COPY SHALL BE RETAINED, NOTWITHSTANDING ANY INCONSISTENT PROVISION OF THIS SECTION, FOR AT LEAST TWO YEARS FROM THE DATE OF PURCHASE; AND
    - I. A RECORDED SIGNATURE OF THE SELLER OR HIS OR HER AGENT.

  - F. SUCH DESCRIPTION OF A PLEDGED ARTICLE AS APPEARS ON SUCH PAWN TICKET OR OTHER EVIDENCE AND AN ACCURATE DESCRIPTION OF EVERY REDEEMED PLEDGED ARTICLE, INCLUDING TYPE OF ARTICLE, MANUFACTURER, MAKE, MODEL NUMBER, SERIAL NUMBER, INTERNATIONAL MOBILE EQUIPMENT IDENTIFIER, ELECTRONIC SERIAL NUMBER, MOBILE EQUIPMENT IDENTIFIER, INSCRIPTIONS OR DISTINGUISHING MARKS, AND ONE OR MORE DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHS REASONABLY CAPTURING THE LIKENESS OF THE ARTICLE.
  - 4. A DEALER IN SECOND-HAND ARTICLES SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBDIVISION AND SUBDIVISIONS ONE AND TWO OF THIS SECTION SHALL ACQUIRE AND MAINTAIN IN GOOD WORKING ORDER THE ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT NECESSARY TO CREATE AND MAINTAIN THE ELECTRONIC RECORDS REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO A COMPUTER WITH INTERNET CONNECTION, AN ELECTRONIC SIGNATURE PAD AND A DIGITAL CAMERA UTILIZING A FILE FORMAT DESIGNATED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE;
  - 5. THE BOOKS AND RECORDS REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION, INCLUDING ANY ELECTRONIC RECORDS REQUIRED BY THIS SUBDIVISION AND SUBDIVISIONS ONE AND TWO OF THIS SECTION, SHALL BE OPEN TO THE INSPECTION OF ANY POLICE OFFICER, THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF STATE OR ANY DEPARTMENTAL INSPECTOR, ANY JUDGE OF THE CRIMINAL COURT, OR ANY PERSON DULY AUTHORIZED IN WRITING FOR SUCH PURPOSES BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE OR BY ANY JUDGE OF THE CRIMINAL COURT, WHO SHALL EXHIBIT SUCH WRITTEN AUTHORITY TO THE DEALER. SUCH RECORDS SHALL ALSO BE OPEN TO THE INSPECTION OF ANY OFFICIAL OR OTHER PERSON IDENTIFIED IN, OR DULY AUTHORIZED IN WRITING PURSUANT TO, ANY OTHER APPLICABLE STATE OR LOCAL LAW;
  - 6. NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO AFFECT OR SUPERSEDE ANY RECORDKEEPING REQUIREMENT IMPOSED BY OR PURSUANT TO ANY OTHER APPLICABLE STATE OR LOCAL LAW.

- 2. EVERY PAWNBROKER SHALL CREATE AT THE TIME OF TRANSACTION AN ELEC-TRONIC RECORD IN ENGLISH, IN A MANNER TO BE SPECIFIED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE BY RULE OR REGULATION, WHICH MAY INCLUDE THE USE OF AN INTERNET WEBSITE DESIGNATED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE, OF EVERY TRANSACTION IN

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WHICH GOODS, ARTICLES OR THINGS, OR ANY PART THEREOF, ARE PAWNED, PLEDGED OR REDEEMED IN THE COURSE OF BUSINESS OF SUCH PAWNBROKER. SUCH ELECTRONIC RECORD SHALL BE RETAINED FOR A MINIMUM PERIOD OF SIX YEARS FROM THE DATE OF THE TRANSACTION. SUCH ELECTRONIC RECORD MAY, IN THE DISCRETION OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE AND IN FURTHERANCE OF THE PURPOSES OF THIS ARTICLE AND ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAW OR RULES REGULATING THE ACTIVITIES OF PAWNBROKERS, INCLUDE BUT SHALL NOT BE LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION, PROVIDED IN A FORMAT OR IN ACCORDANCE WITH SPEC- IFICATIONS AS PROVIDED BY RULE OR REGULATION OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE:

- A. THE DATE, TIME, LOCATION AND TYPE OF TRANSACTION;
- 11 B. THE NAME OF THE INDIVIDUAL CONDUCTING THE TRANSACTION FOR THE PAWN-12 BROKER;
  - C. IDENTIFYING INFORMATION REGARDING THE PLEDGOR, INCLUDING NAME, ADDRESS, PHONE NUMBER, TYPE OF IDENTIFICATION UTILIZED, IDENTIFICATION NUMBER, EXPIRATION DATE OF IDENTIFICATION, DATE OF BIRTH, SEX, HEIGHT, WEIGHT, EYE COLOR, HAIR COLOR, RACE OR ETHNICITY, DISTINGUISHING MARKS, DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPH OF OWNER, DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPH OR SCANNED COPY OF IDENTIFICATION UTILIZED, AND WHETHER THE PLEDGOR IS THE OWNER, CONSIGNEE OR AGENT OF THE OWNER;

AN ACCURATE DESCRIPTION OF EACH ARTICLE PAWNED OR PLEDGED, INCLUDING TYPE OF ARTICLE, MANUFACTURER, MAKE, MODEL NUMBER, SERIAL NUMBER, INTERNATIONAL MOBILE EQUIPMENT IDENTIFIER, ELECTRONIC SERIAL NUMBER, MOBILE EQUIPMENT IDENTIFIER, INSCRIPTIONS OR DISTINGUISHING MARKS, AND ONE OR MORE DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHS REASONABLY CAPTURING THE LIKENESS OF THE ARTICLE;
    - E. THE PLEDGE NUMBER OF THE PAWN TICKET;
  - F. THE AMOUNT LOANED OR ADVANCED THEREON AND THE RATE OF INTEREST TO BE PAID ON SUCH LOAN OR ADVANCE;

NOTWITHSTANDING ANY INCONSISTENT PROVISION OF THIS SUBDIVISION, SUCH ELECTRONIC RECORD SHALL IN ANY EVENT CONTAIN THE INFORMATION SPECIFIED IN SECTION FORTY-THREE OF THIS CHAPTER.

THE PAWNBROKER SHALL ACQUIRE AND MAINTAIN IN GOOD WORKING ORDER THE ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT NECESSARY TO CREATE AND MAINTAIN THE ELECTRONIC RECORDS REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO A COMPUTER WITH INTERNET CONNECTION, AN ELECTRONIC SIGNATURE PAD AND A DIGITAL CAMERA UTILIZING A FILE FORMAT DESIGNATED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE.
- 4. THE ELECTRONIC RECORDS REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION SHALL BE OPEN TO
  THE INSPECTION OF THE STATE ATTORNEY GENERAL, THE STATE COMPTROLLER, ANY
  POLICE OFFICER, THE SECRETARY OF STATE, ANY DEPARTMENTAL INSPECTOR, ANY
  JUDGE OF THE CRIMINAL COURT, ANY PERSON DULY AUTHORIZED IN WRITING FOR
  SUCH PURPOSES BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE OR BY ANY JUDGE OF THE CRIMINAL
  COURT, WHO SHALL EXHIBIT SUCH WRITTEN AUTHORITY TO THE PAWNBROKER OR ANY
  OTHER GOVERNMENTAL OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE AUTHORIZED BY STATE OR LOCAL LAW.
  SOUTH RECORDS SHALL ALSO BE OPEN TO THE INSPECTION OF ANY OFFICIAL OR

1 OTHER PERSON IDENTIFIED IN, OR DULY AUTHORIZED IN WRITING PURSUANT TO 2 SECTION FORTY-FIVE OF THIS CHAPTER OR ANY OTHER APPLICABLE STATE OR 3 LOCAL LAW.

- 5. NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO AFFECT OR SUPERSEDE ANY RECORDKEEPING REQUIREMENT IMPOSED BY OR PURSUANT TO ANY OTHER APPLICABLE STATE OR LOCAL LAW.
- 6. IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER APPLICABLE PENALTY OR SANCTION, ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION OR RULES PROMULGATED THEREUNDER SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE PENALTIES SET FORTH IN SECTION FIFTY-SEVEN-C OF THIS ARTICLE.
- S 57-C. PENALTIES. 1. EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE SPECIFICALLY PROVIDED ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE OR ANY REGULATION OR RULE PROMULGATED UNDER IT SHALL, UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, BE PUNISHED FOR EACH VIOLATION BY A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS NOR MORE THAN FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS, OR BY IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING FIFTEEN DAYS, OR BOTH; AND ANY SUCH PERSON SHALL BE SUBJECT ALSO TO A CIVIL PENALTY IN THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS FOR EACH VIOLATION, TO BE RECOVERED IN A CIVIL ACTION.
- 2. THE ATTORNEY GENERAL IS AUTHORIZED TO BRING AN INJUNCTION PROCEED-20 ING TO RESTRAIN OR ENJOIN ANY VIOLATION OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 21 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 22 have become a law; provided, however, that the secretary of state shall 23 take such measures as are necessary for its implementation, including 24 the promulgation of any rules, or regulations prior to such effective 25 date.
