AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to employment of retired persons without diminution of retirement allowance and period of employment requested by the prospective employer

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The closing paragraph of paragraph (b) of subdivision 2 of section 211 of the retirement and social security law, as amended by chapter 640 of the laws of 2008, is amended to read as follows:

Such approvals SHALL BE GRANTED FOR THE PERIOD OF TIME REQUESTED BY THE PROSPECTIVE EMPLOYER AND may be granted for periods not exceeding two years each, provided that such person may not return to work in the same or similar position for a period of one year following retirement. The authority or officer specified in paragraph (a) of this subdivision, upon approving employment of a retired person under this section, shall certify such approval to the retirement system or pension plan from
