IN SENATE -- Introduced by Sen. LAVALLE -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Local Government -- committee discharged, bill amended, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee

IN ASSEMBLY -- Introduced by M. of A. THIELE -- read once and referred to the Committee on Transportation -- committee discharged, bill amended, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee

AN ACT to grant authority to the village of Sag Harbor, county of Suffolk to regulate certain described waters bounding said village pursuant to the navigation law

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary,  
2     except when prohibited by reason of the laws of the United States or  
3     section 130 of the town law, the village of Sag Harbor, county of  
4     Suffolk is hereby granted jurisdiction to: (a) regulate beaches pursuant  
5     to section 45-b of the navigation law; (b) establish a vessel regulation  
6     zone pursuant to section 46 of the navigation law; and (c) regulate  
7     vessels pursuant to section 46-a of the navigation law, in the waters  
8     within or bounding the village described as follows: Beginning at the  
9     following point, 41 degrees, 0.554 minutes, North, and 72 degrees,  
10    17.663 minutes, West, the point, thence in a straight line generally  
11    easterly to a point, 41 degrees, 0.649 minutes, North and 72 degrees,  
12    15.934 minutes West, thence along the shoreline to the breakwater, and  
13    thence along the breakwater to the place of beginning. The village shall  
14    possess such jurisdiction, notwithstanding that a part of such waters  
15    may be more than fifteen hundred feet from shore.

16    S 2. Severability. The provisions of this act shall be severable and  
17    if any portion thereof or the applicability thereof to any person or  
18    circumstances shall be held invalid, the remainder of this act and the  
19    application thereof shall not be affected thereby.

20    S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
