AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to electronic toll collections

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new 2 section 391-a to read as follows:

3 ELECTRONIC TOLL COLLECTIONS. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF ANY LAW TO THE CONTRARY, ANY TOLL PLAZA, BOOTH OR BARRIER LOCATED IN 5 COUNTY OF ORANGE, ROCKLAND, WESTCHESTER, BRONX, NEW YORK, QUEENS, KINGS, RICHMOND, NASSAU OR SUFFOLK, OPERATING UNDER THE NEW YORK 6 7 AUTHORITY, THE METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY OR THE THRUWAY TRIBOROUGH BRIDGE AND TUNNEL AUTHORITY, SHALL ONLY OFFER AN ELECTRONIC 9 PAYMENT FOR ANY TOLLS, FARES, FEES, OR OTHER CHARGES ASSOCI-METHOD OF 10 ATED WITH TRAVEL ON SUCH ROADS, HIGHWAYS, TUNNELS OR BRIDGES. THE CHAIR-11 PERSON OF EACH AUTHORITY SHALL ESTABLISH, BY RULE OR REGULATION, SUCH ELECTRONIC 12 REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PLACEMENT OF TOLL COLLECTION SYSTEMS. SUCH ELECTRONIC TOLL COLLECTION SYSTEM SHALL INCLUDE BUT NOT BE 13 14 LIMITED TO THE E-ZPASS SYSTEM AND A SYSTEM USED TO CAPTURE THE LICENSE EVERY VEHICLE DRIVEN BY A NON-ELECTRONIC PASS HOLDER. AT THE 15 16 CONCLUSION OF EACH MONTH, THE NEW YORK STATE THRUWAY AUTHORITY, 17 METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY AND THE TRIBOROUGH BRIDGE AND TUNNEL AUTHORITY SHALL COMPILE THE DATA CAPTURED BY SUCH SYSTEM 18 19 NON-ELECTRONIC PASS HOLDERS AND PRODUCE A MONTHLY TOLL STATEMENT TO BE 20 MAILED TO EACH NON-ELECTRONIC PASS HOLDER. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION 21 ERED FROM THE DEPARTMENT SHALL BE USED TO PRODUCE AND POST SUCH MONTHLY 22 STATEMENTS.

S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after it shall have become a law, provided, however, that the chairpersons of the New York state thruway authority, the metropolitan transportation authority and the Triborough bridge and tunnel authority are authorized and directed to promulgate any rules or regulations necessary to implement the provisions of this act on or before such effective date.
