AN ACT authorizing the town of East Hampton, Suffolk county, to establish an underground utility improvement district

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The town of East Hampton, in the county of Suffolk, is hereby authorized to establish an underground utility improvement district pursuant to articles 12 and 12-A of the town law. Such road improvement district shall be established, funded, operated and otherwise controlled by the provisions of articles 12 and 12-A of the town law and the provisions of this act. To the extent that the provisions of this act shall in any way be in conflict with articles 12 and 12-A of the town law, the provisions of this act shall be controlling.

S 2. The purpose of the underground utility improvement district shall be to take such action as may be required to adopt plans and specifications and enter into a contract or contracts, or take such other actions as may be required with a public utility company, municipality, or public authority in order to construct underground new public utility facilities or convert existing overhead public utility facilities to underground facilities. For the purposes of this act, "public utility facilities" shall include the transmission and distribution of electrical energy, telephone lines, and cable television lines, including poles, wires, and all associated structures.

S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
