AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to assaults upon station cleaners and terminal cleaners

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Subdivision 11 of section 120.05 of the penal law, as  
2 amended by chapter 196 of the laws of 2014, is amended to read as  
3 follows:  
4     11. With intent to cause physical injury to a train operator, ticket  
5 inspector, conductor, signalperson, bus operator or station agent  
6 employed by any transit agency, STATION CLEANER OR TERMINAL CLEANER,  
7 authority or company, public or private, whose operation is authorized  
8 by New York state or any of its political subdivisions, a city marshal,  
9 a school crossing guard appointed pursuant to section two hundred  
10 eight-a of the general municipal law, a traffic enforcement officer,  
11 traffic enforcement agent, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-  
12 one of section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law, sanitation enforce-  
13 ment agent, New York city sanitation worker, registered nurse or  
14 licensed practical nurse he or she causes physical injury to such train  
15 operator, ticket inspector, conductor, signalperson, bus operator or  
16 station agent, city marshal, school crossing guard appointed pursuant to  
17 section two hundred eight-a of the general municipal law, traffic  
18 enforcement officer, traffic enforcement agent, STATION CLEANER OR  
19 TERMINAL CLEANER, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of  
20 section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law, registered nurse, licensed  
21 practical nurse, sanitation enforcement agent or New York city sanita-  
22 tion worker, while such employee is performing an assigned duty on, or  
23 directly related to, the operation of a train or bus, or such city  
24 marshal, school crossing guard, traffic enforcement officer, traffic  
25 enforcement agent, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of
