AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to authorizing the state liquor authority to impose a one year moratorium on the issuance of new licenses to sell liquor on premises in certain instances

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 17 of the alcoholic beverage  
2     control law, as amended by chapter 118 of the laws of 2012, is amended  
3     to read as follows:  
4     2. To limit in its discretion the number of licenses of each class to  
5     be issued within the state or any political subdivision thereof, and in  
6     connection therewith to prohibit the acceptance of applications for such  
7     class or classes of licenses which have been so limited.     PROVIDED,  
8     HOWEVER, IN CITIES HAVING A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE, (A) UPON  
9     RECEIPT OF (I) A REQUEST FROM THE STATE SENATOR OR STATE SENATORS AND  
10    ASSEMBLY MEMBER OR ASSEMBLY MEMBERS REPRESENTING THE RESIDENTS OF A  
11    NEIGHBORHOOD WITHIN A CITY HAVING A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE  
12    AND (II) A RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY A COMMUNITY BOARD OR BOARDS OR OTHER  
13    LOCAL BODY OR BODIES WHOSE JURISDICTION COVERS SUCH NEIGHBORHOOD  
14    REQUESTING A MORATORIUM WITHIN SUCH NEIGHBORHOOD ON THE ISSUANCE OF NEW  
15    LICENSES TO SELL LIQUOR AT RETAIL FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES ISSUED  
16    PURSUANT TO SECTIONS SIXTY-FOUR, SIXTY-FOUR-A, SIXTY-FOUR-B,  
17    SIXTY-FOUR-C AND SIXTY-FOUR-D OF THIS CHAPTER AND (B) A FINDING BY THE  
18    AUTHORITY THAT THE NUMBER OF SUCH LICENSES ISSUED WITHIN SUCH NEIGHBOR-  
19    HOOD PURSUANT TO SECTIONS SIXTY-FOUR, SIXTY-FOUR-A, SIXTY-FOUR-B,  
20    SIXTY-FOUR-C AND SIXTY-FOUR-D OF THIS CHAPTER HAS DOUBLED OVER A THREE

1 THIS CHAPTER AND THE ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS FOR SUCH LICENSES.  
2 NOTHING CONTAINED IN THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL PREVENT THE TRANSFER OF ANY  
3 LICENSE AT THE SAME PREMISES UNDER THIS CHAPTER. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS  
4 SUBDIVISION, "NEIGHBORHOOD" MEANS A GEOGRAPHIC AREA WITHIN A CITY HAVING  
5 A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE THAT IS RECOGNIZED BY THE RESIDENTS  
6 THEREOF AS INCLUDING A UNIQUE COMMUNITY OF INTERESTS.

7 S 2. Subdivision 2 of section 17 of the alcoholic beverage control  
8 law, as amended by chapter 83 of the laws of 1995, is amended to read as  
9 follows:

10 2. To limit in its discretion the number of licenses of each class to  
11 be issued within the state or any political subdivision thereof, and in  
12 connection therewith to prohibit the acceptance of applications for such  
13 class or classes of licenses which have been so limited. PROVIDED,  
14 HOWEVER, IN CITIES HAVING A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE, (A) UPON  
15 RECEIPT OF (I) A REQUEST FROM THE STATE SENATOR OR STATE SENATORS AND

34 SUBDIVISION, "NEIGHBORHOOD" MEANS A GEOGRAPHIC AREA WITHIN A CITY HAVING  
35 A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE THAT IS RECOGNIZED BY THE RESIDENTS  
36 THEREOF AS INCLUDING A UNIQUE COMMUNITY OF INTERESTS.

37 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately, provided that the amend-  
38 ments to subdivision 2 of section 17 of the alcoholic beverage control  
39 law made by section one of this act shall be subject to the expiration  
40 and reversion of such subdivision pursuant to section 4 of chapter 118  
41 of the laws of 2012, as amended, when upon such date the provisions of  
42 section two of this act shall take effect.
