AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to the designation of the "United States Submarine Veterans' Memorial Highway"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-e to 2 read as follows:

- S 344-E. PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE "UNITED STATES SUBMARINE VETERANS' MEMORIAL HIGHWAY". THAT PORTION OF STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 9 IN THE TOWNS OF HALFMOON, CLIFTON PARK, MALTA, SARATOGA SPRINGS, GREENFIELD, AND WILTON COMMENCING IN SOUTHERN SARATOGA COUNTY, AT THE NORTHERN END OF THE CRESCENT BRIDGE AND BETWEEN VISCHER FERRY ROAD AND CHURCH HILL ROAD CONTINUING ALONG ROUTE 9 THROUGH THE TOWNS OF HALFMOON, CLIFTON PARK, MALTA, SARATOGA SPRINGS, GREENFIELD AND WILTON, TERMINATING AT THE CORNER OF ROUTE 9 AND BALLARD ROAD IN THE TOWN OF WILTON SHALL BE DESIGNATED AS THE "UNITED STATES SUBMARINE VETERANS' MEMORIAL HIGHWAY".
- S 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the designation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of a ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be changed as the result of this act.
- 20 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
