AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring teachers colleges to provide a course of instruction in mental health first aid

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 305 of the education law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 55 to read as follows:
- 55. A. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ESTABLISH AND ENFORCE RULES AND REGU-4 LATIONS REQUIRING EVERY COLLEGE FOR TEACHERS OR TEACHERS COLLEGE WITHIN 5 THE STATE TO PROVIDE A COURSE OF INSTRUCTION IN MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID 6 TO EACH STUDENT PRIOR TO SUCH STUDENT'S GRADUATION THEREFROM WITH A 7 DEGREE IN TEACHING OR EDUCATION.
- 8 B. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDIVISION, "MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID"
  9 MEANS THE RECOGNITION OF COMMON MENTAL ILLNESSES AND CHEMICAL DEPENDENCE
  10 DISORDERS, THE SAFE DE-ESCALATION OF CRISIS SITUATIONS, AND THE INITI11 ATION OF TIMELY REFERRAL OF APPROPRIATE STUDENTS TO MENTAL HEALTH AND
  12 CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY RESOURCES WITHIN THE COMMUNITY.
- 13 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 14 have become a law.
