AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to murder in the first degree where the intended victim was a child twelve years of age or younger

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subparagraph (xiii) of paragraph (a) of subdivision 1 of section 125.27 of the penal law, as added by chapter 300 of the laws of 2001, is amended and a new subparagraph (xiv) is added to read as follows: 5 (xiii) the victim was killed in furtherance of an act of terrorism, as

6 defined in paragraph (b) of subdivision one of section 490.05 of this 7 chapter; [and] OR

8 (XIV) THE INTENDED VICTIM WAS A CHILD TWELVE YEARS OF AGE OR YOUNGER; 9 AND

10 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-11 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
