AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the school district internal audit function

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 2116-b of the education added by chapter 263 of the laws of 2005, is amended to read as follows: 3 1. No later than July first, two thousand six, each school district shall establish an internal audit function to be in operation no later 5 than the following December thirty-first. Such function shall include: (a) development of a risk assessment of district operations, including 6 7 limited to, a review of financial policies and procedures and but not the testing and evaluation of district internal controls; (b) [an annual] A BIENNIAL review and update of such risk assessment; and (c) prepa-9 10 ration of reports, at least annually or more frequently as the trustees 11 or board of education may direct, which analyze significant risk assessment findings, recommend changes for strengthening controls and reducing 12 identified risks, and specify timeframes for implementation of such 13 14 recommendations.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
