AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to granting peace officer status to certain security services officers employed by Albany Medical Center

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 2.10 of the criminal procedure law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 84 to read as follows:
- 3 MEMBERS OF THE SECURITY FORCE EMPLOYED BY ALBANY MEDICAL CENTER WITHIN AND DIRECTLY ADJACENT TO THE BUILDINGS ON THEMEDICAL CENTER CAMPUS LOCATED AT 43 NEW SCOTLAND AVE, ALBANY, NEW YORK; ALBANY MEDICAL 5 COLLEGE, 47 NEW SCOTLAND AVE IN ALBANY, NEW YORK; THE ADJACENT AND SEPA-6 7 RATE GARAGES LOCATED AT 40 NEW SCOTLAND AVE, 60 NEW SCOTLAND AVE, 8 AVE, ALBANY, NEW YORK; ADJACENT MEDICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE MYRTLE BUILDINGS LOCATED AT 391 MYRTLE AVE, 16 NEW SCOTLAND AVE, 22 NEW SCOT-9 LAND AVE, 50 NEW SCOTLAND AVE; 628 MADISON AVE, IN ALBANY, NEW YORK; THE 10 SOUTH CLINICAL CAMPUS AND ADJACENT BUILDINGS LOCATED AT 23 HACKETT BLVD, 11 25 HACKETT BLVD, 35 HACKETT BLVD, 58-60 HACKETT BLVD, 1 CLARA BARTON DR; 12 ALBANY, NEW YORK; AND THE 1275 BROADWAY BUILDING 13 JAMES PL, ST. LOCATED IN MENANDS, NEW YORK, ALL OF WHICH ARE OWNED OR OPERATED BY 14 15 ALBANY MEDICAL CENTER. THESE OFFICERS SHALL ONLY HAVE THE POWERS IN SECTION 9.41 OF THE MENTAL HYGIENE LAW AND THE POWERS 16 LISTED IN17 GRAPHS (A), (B), (C), (D), (H), (I) AND (J) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION 2.20 OF THIS ARTICLE. PROVIDED THAT IN ORDER 18 TO EXERCISE
- 19 POWERS SET FORTH IN PARAGRAPHS (A), (B) AND (D) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF
- 20 SECTION 2.20 OF THIS ARTICLE, THE OFFICER HAS ACTUAL KNOWLEDGE, OR PROB-21 ABLE CAUSE TO BELIEVE, THAT SUCH INDIVIDUAL HAS COMMITTED AN OFFENSE;
- 22 PROVIDED HOWEVER, THAT NOTHING IN THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE DEEMED TO
- 23 AUTHORIZE SUCH OFFICER TO CARRY, POSSESS, REPAIR OR DISPOSE OF A FIREARM
- 24 UNLESS THE APPROPRIATE LICENSE THEREFOR HAS BEEN ISSUED PURSUANT TO
- 25 SECTION 400.00 OF THE PENAL LAW.
- 26 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
