ACT to amend the New York city charter and the agriculture and markets law, in relation to granting concurrent jurisdiction to city of New York department of health and mental hygiene to conduct inspections of retail food stores and farmers' markets; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 556 of the New York city charter is amended by adding a new subdivision f to read as follows:

- JURISDICTION OVER RETAIL FOOD STORES AND FARMERS' MARKETS. EXERCISE, CONCURRENTLY WITH THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS, JURISDICTION TO CONDUCT INSPECTIONS OF RETAIL FOOD STORES FARMERS' MARKETS WITHIN THE GEOGRAPHICAL LIMIT OF ITS JURISDICTION TO DETERMINE COMPLIANCE WITH ALL PROVISIONS OF THEAGRICULTURE MARKETS LAW AND THE REGULATIONS PROMULGATED THEREUNDER, WHICH APPLY TO RETAIL FOOD STORES AND FARMERS' MARKETS. THE RESULTS OF CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE REFERRED TO THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS FOR APPROPRIATE ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS; PROVIDED THAT IF THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICUL-IMPOSES 13 AND MARKETS ANY MONETARY PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION OF THE AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS LAW AND THE REGULATIONS PROMULGATED AN INSPECTION CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION, 15 A RESULT OF FIFTY PERCENT OF THE REVENUE RESULTING FROM SUCH PENALTY SHALL 17 TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR DEPOSIT IN THE GENERAL FUND OF THE CITY; AND

CISE OF JURISDICTION PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION, SO THAT THERE CONTINUITY OF REGULATORY CONTROL AND ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS AMONG THE ENTI-3 TIES.

- Section 16 of the agriculture and markets law is amended by adding a new subdivision 49 to read as follows:
- 5 6 49. EXERCISE, CONCURRENTLY WITH THE NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH 7 AND MENTAL HYGIENE, JURISDICTION TO CONDUCT INSPECTIONS OF RETAIL FOOD STORES AND FARMERS' MARKETS WITHIN THE CITY OF NEW YORK. THE COMMISSION-8 9 SHALL COORDINATE AND COOPERATE WITH THE NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF 10 HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE WITH RESPECT TO SUCH CONCURRENT EXERCISE COMMISSIONER MAY PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS TO 11 JURISDICTION. THEEFFECTUATE SUCH CONCURRENT EXERCISE OF JURISDICTION. UPON IMPOSITION OF 12 ANY MONETARY PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS CHAPTER AND THE REGULATIONS 13 14 PROMULGATED THEREUNDER, WHICH IS IMPOSED AS A RESULT OF AN INSPECTION 15 CONDUCTED BY THE NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL CAUSE FIFTY PERCENT OF THE REVENUE RESULTING FROM 16 17 SUCH PENALTY TO BE PAID TO THE NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE FOR DEPOSIT IN THE GENERAL FUND OF THE CITY. 18
- 19 S 3. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall have become a law and shall expire and be deemed repealed 2 years after 20 21 such effective date.
