

Assembly Resolution No. 1180

in relation to the election and seating of
Christopher Tague as a Member of the Assembly from
the 102nd Assembly District

WHEREAS, There is a vacancy existing in the membership of this House, which was filled at a special election held on April 24, 2018; and

WHEREAS, The final official canvass of the votes cast at said election and certification thereof of the person elected thereat, cannot be made at this time; and

WHEREAS, The board of elections of the State of New York has advised that the votes cast for the Office of Member of Assembly in the 102nd Assembly District in the counties of Albany, Columbia, Delaware, Greene, Otsego, Schoharie and Ulster shown by its canvass were respectively as follows: Aidan S. O'Connor Jr., Democratic, Working Families and Women's Equality, eight thousand nine hundred ninety-seven; Christopher Tague, Republican, Conservative, Independence and Reform, nine thousand one hundred fifty-six, and Wesley D. Laraway, Best Choice, one thousand nine hundred fourteen; and

WHEREAS, It appears that the results of the votes cast in said Assembly District cannot be affected by the final official canvass of such voters; and

WHEREAS, Christopher Tague has duly taken an oath of office as a Member of Assembly; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That Christopher Tague, Republican, Conservative, Independence and Reform, is duly elected and qualified as a Member of the Assembly for his respective district and that he be seated in this House as such Member.
