WHEREAS, A Long Island native who worked from age 10 at this grandfather's bakery and pizza restaurant, Angelo Mazzone began his empire at a small downtown Schenectady restaurant called Peggy's in 1980; and

WHEREAS, Through the years Angelo Mazzone built his business and secured the purchase of Glen Sanders Mansion in Scotia in 1988; today, under his luminous leadership, the Mazzone Hospitality Restaurant Division runs six restaurants from Albany to Saratoga, and includes catering, event and PRIME business dining divisions, the latter offering cafeteria-style dining within Capital Region corporate offices, with meals designed by great chefs; and

WHEREAS, Inspired by his family's strong Italian traditions, Angelo Mazzone has never lost sight of contributing to his community; he generously supports the Culinary and Hospitality Program at Schenectady County Community College, The American Heart Association, The American Cancer Association, SPAC, Proctors Theatre and the Palace Theater; and

WHEREAS, The University at Albany Foundation recognizes and appreciates Angelo Mazzone's brilliant leadership, vision and commitment to quality, as well as his significant role in transforming the local culinary experience; and
