AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring an educational awareness campaign relative to the dangers of acting as a pedestrian while distracted by using a mobile device

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding a new section 19-196 to read as follows:
- § 19-196 Pedestrian while distracted by texting program. 1. The 4 commissioner shall develop a citywide awareness campaign that will 5 educate pedestrians of the dangers of acting as a pedestrian while 6 distracted by texting, or other uses of a mobile device. The campaign shall include communications that educate pedestrians about the dangers 8 of using a mobile device while traversing an intersection, and the 9 dangers of using a mobile device while being near or in a street.
- 10 2. The department is authorized to promulgate any rules and requlations that are necessary to establish the awareness campaign required 11 12 by subdivision one of this section.
- 13 3. The department is further authorized to determine the most appro-14 priate method to conduct the awareness campaign, which shall not be 15 limited to the use of a certain form of communication.
- 16 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
