AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to renaming the Newkirk Avenue rapid transit station in Brooklyn the "Newkirk Avenue -- Little Haiti" station

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The public authorities law is amended by adding a new
2 section 1205-b to read as follows:

3 § 1205-b. Newkirk Avenue -- Little Haiti station. Notwithstanding any
4 other law to the contrary, the rapid transit station on the IRT Nostrand
5 Avenue Line of the New York City Subway located at the intersection of
6 Newkirk and Nostrand Avenues in Brooklyn and known as the "Newkirk
7 Avenue" station shall, after the effective date of this section, be
8 known as the "Newkirk Avenue -- Little Haiti" station and shall be suit-
9 ably marked in a manner to be prescribed by the chairman of the New York
10 city transit authority or his or her delegate.

11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
