Introduced by M. of $A$. BURGOS -- read once and referred to the Committee on Labor

AN $A C T$ to amend the labor law, in relation to reducing the number of hours in a work week to thirty-two for employers with at least five hundred employees

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The labor law is amended by adding a new section 160-a to read as follows:
§ 160-a. Hours to constitute a week's work. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a legal week's work shall consist of thirty-two hours for any employer with at least five hundred employees who are not part of a collective bargaining agreement.
2. No employee compensation shall be reduced due to the reduction in hours considered a legal week's work under this section.
3. This section shall not prevent an agreement for overwork at an increased compensation of at least one hundred fifty percent of the employee's base compensation.
§ 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2024.
