AN ACT to authorize Kevin Brischoux to receive certain service credit under section 384-d of the retirement and social security law

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, Kevin Brischoux, a member of the New York state and local police and fire retirement system, who was employed as a police officer with the town of Goshen, from July 14, 2002 through November 2, 2003, and who, through no fault of his own, failed to file a timely application to participate in the special twenty-year retirement plan contained in section 384-d of the retirement and social security law resulting in the crediting of his service with the town of Goshen in the general retirement plan contained in section 375-c of such law, shall be granted such service credit under section 384-d of the retirement and social security law for his period of employment with the town of Goshen, provided a request to that effect is filed with the state comptroller within one year from the effective date of this act.

- 14 § 2. All employer past service costs associated with implementing the 15 provisions of this act shall be borne by the town of Goshen and may be 16 amortized over a period of ten years.
- 17 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
