AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Catholic War Veterans Memorial Highway"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-n to read as follows:

§ 344-n. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the "Catholic War Veterans Memorial Highway". All that portion of the state highway system constituting route 32, from its intersection with Quaker Avenue in the town of Cornwall, county of Orange, and continuing north to its intersection with state route 94 in the town of New Windsor, county of Orange, shall be designated and known as the "Catholic War Veterans Memorial Highway".

§ 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the designation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be changed as a result of this act.

§ 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
