AN ACT to amend the workers' compensation law, in relation to claims for mental injury premised upon extraordinary work-related stress

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 3 of section 10 of the workers' compensation law, as added by section 1 of subpart I of part NNN of chapter 59 of the laws of 2017, is amended to read as follows:

(b) Where a [~~police officer or firefighter subject to section thirty of this article, or emergency medical technician, paramedic, or other person certified to provide medical care in emergencies, or emergency dispatcher~~] worker files a claim for mental injury premised upon extraordinary work-related stress incurred [~~in a work-related emergency~~] at work, the board may not disallow the claim[~~7~~] upon a factual finding that the stress was not greater than that which usually occurs in the normal work environment.

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
