AN ACT to amend the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law and the tax law, in relation to allowing certain off-track betting corporations to host additional video lottery gaming devices

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 503 of the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law is amended by adding a new subdivision 10-a to read as follows:

10-a. In the Suffolk region, to install and operate up to two thousand video lottery gaming terminals at a corporation's facility which is licensed pursuant to section one thousand eight or one thousand nine of this chapter;

§ 2. Paragraph 3 of subdivision a of section 1617-a of the tax law, as added by section 1 of part SS of chapter 60 of the laws of 2016, is amended to read as follows:

(3) a maximum of two facilities, which shall be vendors for all purposes under this article[~~, neither to exceed one thousand video lottery gaming devices,~~] established within region three of zone one as defined by section one thousand three hundred ten of the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law, one each operated by a corporation established pursuant to section five hundred two of the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law in the Suffolk region and the Nassau region to be located within a facility authorized pursuant to sections one thousand eight or one thousand nine of the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law, provided however, that in the Nassau region

1 such facility shall not exceed one thousand video lottery gaming devices
