AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to directing the public service commission study the feasibility and the costs of burying all or most of the electrical, telephone and internet transmission lines in New York state and to publish and deliver a report of its findings to the governor and the legislature, and requiring new electrical, telephone and internet transmission lines to be buried underground

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The public service law is amended by adding two new sections 119-d and 119-e to read as follows:

§ 119-d. Buried line study. 1. The commission shall conduct a study to analyze the feasibility and the costs of burying underground all or most of the existing electrical, telephone and internet transmission lines in New York state. Such study shall include an analysis of:

(a) the economic and environmental benefits from burying such existing lines; and

(b) the economic cost burden of doing so, if any, including an estimate of what the cost per utility customer would be, the number of jobs to be created to complete the project and a timeline for completion of the project.

2. In analyzing costs and benefits for the purposes of this study, the commission shall consider the varying geographical areas of the state and report separately on the impact particular areas might have on the project. The study shall also quantify the economic costs and benefits of burying existing electrical, telephone and internet transmission

5 3. Within one hundred eighty days of the effective date of this  
6 section, the commission shall:

7 (a) publish the report of its findings on its website in a location  
8 accessible to the public; and

9 (b) deliver a copy of the report to the governor, the temporary presi-  
10 dent of the senate, the speaker of the assembly, the chair of the senate  
11 energy and telecommunications committee and the chair of the assembly  
12 energy committee.

13 § 119-e. Buried lines. 1. Notwithstanding any law, rule or regulation  
14 to the contrary, to the greatest extent possible, all new electrical,  
15 telephone and internet transmission lines installed in the state shall  
16 be buried underground.

17 2. The provisions of this section shall apply to electrical, telephone  
18 and internet transmission lines for which preliminary permits are issued  
19 on and after the effective date of this section.

20 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
