AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to designating tactical medical providers employed by a municipal police department as peace officers

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 2.10 of the criminal procedure law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 86 to read as follows:
- 86. A tactical medical provider designated by the head of a municipal police department or sheriff; provided, however, that nothing in this subdivision shall be deemed to authorize such officer to carry, possess,
- 6 repair or dispose of a firearm unless the appropriate license therefor 7 has been issued pursuant to section 400.00 of the penal law. For
- 8 purposes of this subdivision a tactical medical provider shall mean a
- 9 <u>licensed physician, paramedic or emergency medical technician.</u>
- 10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
