AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to loitering

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 240.35 of the penal law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 7 to read as follows:

7. Loiters or remains in any transportation facility, within twentyfive feet of the token booth or similar location, for more than twentyfive minutes, unless specifically authorized to do so, unless because of
the facility's size or design it would be impossible to maintain such
distance.

8 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day next succeeding 9 the date on which it shall have become a law.
