Introduced by M. of A. BARNWELL -- read once and referred to the Committee on Cities

AN ACT to amend the general city law, in relation to requiring that a master plumber inspect a premises within twenty-four hours of a gas leak in order to reopen gas lines

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The general city law is amended by adding a new section
2 18-e to read as follows:

3 § 18-e. Timeliness of the inspections following gas service
4 disruptions. In a city with a population of five hundred thousand or
5 more, in which an inspection by a master plumber is required before gas
6 services can be restored following such services being disrupted, a
7 master plumber shall inspect a residential premises within twenty-four
8 hours of such services being disrupted.

9 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
